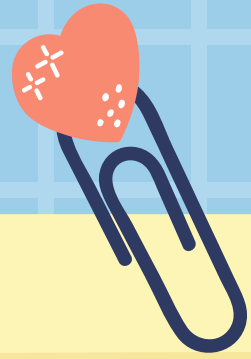
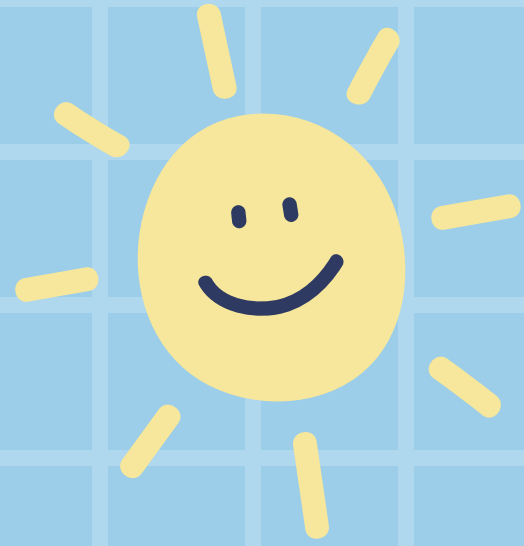

Be a Respectful Guest

- Respect the hotel property of which you are a guest. Individuals will be responsible for any property damage or loss that occurs due to their stay during the conference.
- Participants shall not play loud music and will keep their volume low while they are in rooms. Participants are to be in their rooms for the night by 10pm.
- Girls' hotel rooms are off limits to boys' and boys' rooms are off limits to girls unless a teacher is present.
- Participants shall not leave the conference/hotel premises without permission from their teacher. Participants shall keep their teacher informed of their activities and whereabouts at all times.





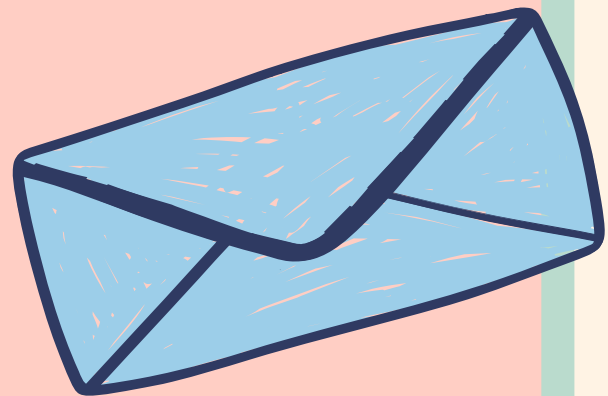
Rules for the Pool

- All participants must be accompanied to the pool by a Teacher Leader.
- Please respect other guests at the pool.
- Loud and rowdy behavior will not be tolerated.
- Violation of these rules will result in chapters being revoked of their pool privileges.



Dress Code

- While competing, participants **MUST** be dressed in business casual attire.
- When not competing, casual clothes including jeans (without holes) may be worn with a chapter or conference t-shirt.
- Please see the following slides for examples of appropriate business casual attire.





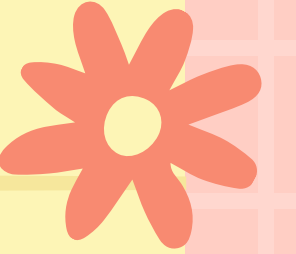
Slacks/Pants

- Slacks or Pants that are similar to Dockers.
- Dressy capris, and nice looking synthetic dress pants are acceptable.
- Inappropriate slacks or pants include: jeans, sweatpants, exercise pants, shorts, leggings, and spandex .





Skirts and Dresses



- Dresses and skirts, and skirts that are split at or below the knee are acceptable.
- Dress and skirt length should be at a length at which you can sit comfortably in public.
- Mini-skirts, skorts, sun dresses, beach dresses, and spaghetti-strap dresses are inappropriate.

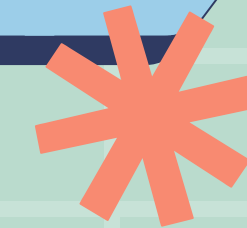
Shirts, Tops, Blouses, and Jackets

- Casual shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, tops, blazers and polo shirts are acceptable. Educators Rising polo shirts are encouraged.
- Inappropriate attire includes tank tops; midriff tops; shirts with potentially offensive content, halter tops; sweatshirts, and t-shirts.
- Educators Rising, conference and chapter t-shirts may be worn when not competing.





Shoes and Footwear



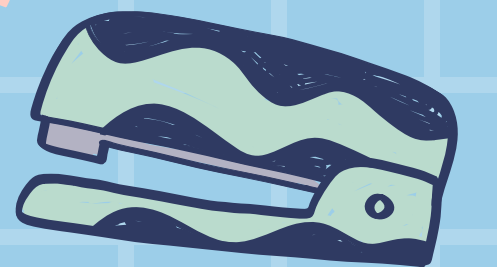
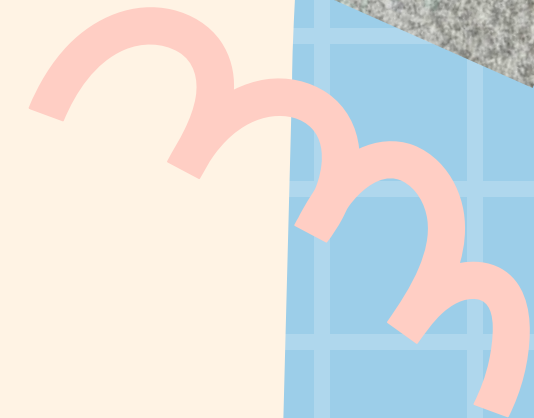
- Conservative athletic shoes, loafers, clogs, sneakers, boots, flats, dress heels, and leather decktype shoes are acceptable.
- Flashy athletic shoes, Crocs, flip-flops, and slippers are not acceptable.





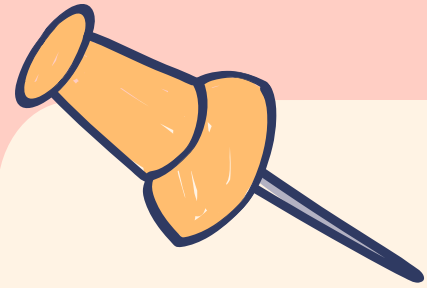
Name Badge

- Please wear your Educators Rising State Conference lanyard and name badge at all times, including off site social events!

Competition Guidelines



- Review the competition schedule closely so you know when you are scheduled to compete.
